David Simpson	Shayna Wyasket

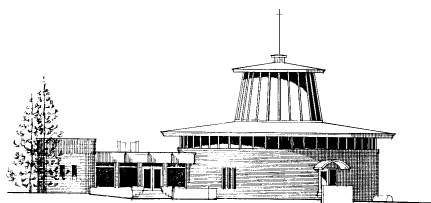
