Our mission is to “Live God’s Love in the World.” The ministries of Mount Tabor begin at home and extend into our communities, our nation and the world. A few of our local ministries include:

Family Promise SLC

The mission of Family Promise is to help homeless families achieve lasting self-sufficiency. We partner with other local faith communities to serve meals and provide safe shelter to homeless families as they transition to stable housing.

12-Step Groups

We host several 12-Step recovery groups each week. Tabor is known as a “Hub of Recovery” in Salt Lake City.

Crossroads Urban Center Coalition of Religious Communities

Crossroads Urban Center helps low-income, disabled and minority Utahans to meet basic survival needs. Every year, Mount Tabor donates food,

diapers, clothing, and financial contributions to Crossroads.

Dinner at Vinny’s

Tabor members volunteer monthly with Catholic Social Services to serve the evening meal at St Vincent dePaul kitchen downtown.

Our other important social action ministries include the Utah Food Bank, Homeless Youth Resource Center, and ELCA World Hunger.
